BRADLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Deadline May 1

PURPOSE

God has blessed First United Methodist Church with a Memorial Scholarship Fund provided by the family of J. C., Mayme and Jim Bradley. This memorial is for college scholarships, and it is the hope of the committee that this will impact a student's ability to continue his/her education. This application will help the First United Methodist Church Scholarship Committee, comprised of two church staff members and one or more educators, recommend the allocation of these funds.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- This application will be used to determine an applicant's qualifications for any scholarships administered by First United Methodist Church.
- The applicant must be a high school graduate applying for admission to or already attending a college or university.
- Scholarships will be awarded to those pursuing studies in any field or to those postgraduate students pursuing a degree.
- In order to be eligible for consideration, applicants must complete all items on the application and submit it to the church office before the deadline date.
- Monies will be allocated on a term basis not to exceed the \$3,000 annual scholarship. Following the first term of enrollment, proof of continuing enrollment and current GPA must be provided to the First United Methodist Church Scholarship Committee.
- This application is valid for one year. A new application must be submitted each year one applies for this scholarship.

INSTRUCTIONS

- All applications must be completed, signed and returned to the office of First United Methodist Church before May 1 of the scholastic year for which you are applying, either by mail postmarked by May 1 or hand delivered. Those applications received after May 1 will not be considered in the application process.
- Answers to the essay questions must be typed. Additional paper will be required to answer essay questions, so please be sure your name is on each page. The committee places much emphasis on the content of these essays.
- One teacher recommendation must be submitted. The recommendation should come from a professional educator from this academic year or from a school counselor. Provide the teacher with a stamped envelope addressed to First United Methodist Church Scholarship Committee, 101 East First North Street, Morristown, TN 37814. Write on the envelope and also remind the teacher that the recommendation must be postmarked by May 1.
- If you have any questions, please call the church office and leave your name and number with the church secretary. A member of the Scholarship Committee will return your call. Please do not ask questions of the secretary.
